NO FLY ZONE – CLARE AND PORT PIRIE HELIPAD QUESTIONS REMAIN

State Labor is under pressure to justify why 6 regional hospital helipads including Clare and Port Pirie in the electorate of Grey remain too unsafe for MedSTAR pilots to land. Tom Venning MP Member for Grey echoes the sentiment of State colleague Penny Pratt MP Member for Frome who is deeply concerned that significant money has been wasted by Labor, and that safety and response times for critical healthcare are putting lives at risk. *‘The State Government and SA Health must swiftly resolve these issues...’*
